







Recycling Program For Charlotte County

Do your part ... Preserve the Beauty of Charlotte County!

<p><u>Bin #1</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Newspapers• Junk Mail• Magazines• Phone Books• Paperboard• 3' x 3' Cardboard under the bin	
<p><u>Bin #2</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plastic Containers (Codes 1 & 2 ONLY)• Steel Cans (no lids)• Clear, Brown, Green Glass• Aluminum Cans	
<p><u>Motor Oil & Oil Filter Recycling</u></p> <p>Residents living in Port Charlotte, unincorporated Punta Gorda, and Englewood can recycle their used oil filter along with the used motor oil.</p> <p><u>Motor Oil</u> - Put motor oil in a clean, clear plastic gallon container with screw cap and USED OIL label at the curb on your regular trash day. DO NOT place in trash container.</p> <p><u>Oil Filters</u> - Place your drained oil filter in a clear plastic newspaper sleeve or in a ziplock bag with a USED OIL label at the curb on your regular trash day.</p>	
<p><u>Tires & Lead Acid Batteries</u></p> <p>Charlotte County residents in unincorporated areas can recycle six (6) passenger tires (with or without rims) per year curbside on their recycling day.</p> <p>All residents in unincorporated Charlotte County can recycle car or truck batteries at the curb on their regular trash day.</p>	

Charlotte County Solid Waste Programs

Garbage: Garbage is collected twice a week. Please keep toys, bikes, and other “keepers” away from the curb on collection days. That way they will not be “trashed” by mistake.

Curbside Yard Trash: Place your yard trash either loose in a garbage can, paper lawn/leaf bag, or you can bundle it. The cans or bundles cannot weigh more than 40 pounds each. Limbs cannot be more than six (6) feet in length and ten (10) inches in diameter. Yard trash will NOT be picked up at the curb in plastic bags.

Special Collection Services: Waste Management provides two (2) *no-charge* curbside collections of unbundled yard trash, refuse, or bulky items per year from each residential unit (does not include disaster related clean up or construction and demolition debris from renovation or home improvement). Residents should notify Waste Management at 629-1106 or toll-free (877) 567-2974 to request this service. Each pick up should not exceed ten (10) cubic yards.

Whitegoods Program (stoves, washers, household furnishings, and bedding): Single-family residents can dispose of old furniture and appliances at no extra charge. Place items at the curb and the route drivers will notify Waste Management to schedule service. NOTE: Remove doors from refrigerators and dishwashers.

Waste Tire Collection: Six (6) residential tires per year can be picked up curbside, with or without rims. Tires should be placed with recycle bins, maximum of two (2) tires at a time. ONLY passenger or light truck tires will be accepted.

Used Motor Oil & Oil Filter Collection: Place used motor oil in a clean, clear plastic gallon container with screw cap. Put the drained oil filter in a clear plastic newspaper sleeve or in a ziplock bag. Place an orange USED OIL label on the oil and filter and place at the curb on your regular trash day. Orange USED OIL labels can be obtained in stores that sell oil or in government offices or by calling Waste Management.

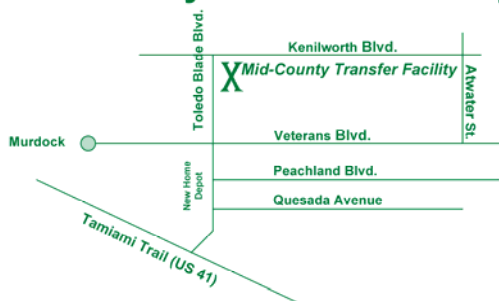
Household Hazardous Waste & Sharps: Charlotte County has two (2) Mini Transfer & Recycling Facilities located in Murdock and Englewood. These facilities are for **Charlotte County residents only**. NO Business Waste will be accepted.

Examples: hypodermic needles, paint, pesticides, antifreeze, gasoline, lawn and pool chemicals, and rechargeable batteries.
